Psalm 145:1-5

Praise the Lord. Praise the Lord, my soul. I will praise the Lord all my life; I will sing praise to my God as long as I live. Do not put your trust in princes, in human beings, who cannot save. When their spirit departs, they return to the ground; on that very day their plans come to nothing. Blessed are those whose help is the God of Jacob, whose hope is in the Lord their God.

An Opportunity to enjoy God's forgiveness

We, who have received so much from our God, are sometimes guilty of failing to share that good news for fear of what people will say to us or think of us. Psalm 107 says 'Give thanks to the Lord, for He is good; His love endures for ever. Let the redeemed of the Lord tell their story'. The psalmist encourages us to tell our story of God's work in our lives and Jesus calls us to make disciples, yet we find it so hard. We come today to confess our lack of boldness and to ask God to forgive us and empower us. We say together God our Father, we come to you in sorrow for our sins. For turning away from you, and ignoring your will for our lives; Father, forgive us: save us and help us. For failing you by what we do, and think and say; Father, forgive us: save us and help us. For living as if we were ashamed to belong to your Son; Father, forgive us: save us and help us. By Your Spirit grant us boldness to speak of you. In Jesus, name. Amen.

Read these words of comfort: 1 Peter 2:24-25

'Jesus himself bore our sins' in his body on the cross, so that we might die to sins and live for righteousness; 'by his wounds you have been healed.' ²⁵ For 'you were like sheep going astray,' but now you have returned to the Shepherd and Overseer of your souls.

May the God of love and power forgive us and free us from our sins, heal and strengthen us by his Spirit, and raise us to new life in Christ our Lord. Amen.

Heavenly Father, Your steadfast love towards us is very precious and we love You, and yet our love varies, we pray that You would help us to love You more and more with every passing day. In Jesus' name we pray. Amen.
